DeLand Outdoor Art Festival Student Division Rules

for Students in Grades K-12

Grade Divisions: K - 2nd, 3rd - 5th, 6th - 8th, 9th - 12th
Student Division Display Saturday, March 28, ONLY

The objective of the Student Division of the DeLand Outdoor Art Festival is to encourage the community's young people in their creative pursuits. However, \$210 in prize money is at stake, so we must ask the cooperation of the young artists and their parents in following the rules set forth below. We want the Student Division to be a positive learning experience for all and a fair competition for all the artists who enter — fair and fun. Thank you.

1. Student Division applications, completed in full, must be received at the offices of *The West Volusia Beacon*, 110 W. New York Ave., DeLand, FL 32720, **no later than 5 p.m. Tuesday, March 24**. Artists whose applications are late may exhibit their work, but their artwork may not be considered for judging.
 2. **Students may enter up to 5 items, and these may be in one or more media.** There is no fee to enter the Student Division.
 3. **Students are responsible for their own displays.** A display may be as simple as a blanket on the grass, a folding table, or a simple easel. Artwork need not be framed or mounted, but the festival is outdoors, so artwork may need to be protected from blowing away. Be prepared for sun, wind or rain.
 4. **All student exhibits must be fully set up by 10 a.m. on Saturday, March 28.** Students must stay with their artwork from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. on March 28. Judging will begin at 10 a.m., and Student Division awards will be presented at 2 p.m. March 28. All artwork must be removed by 4 p.m. Saturday, March 28.
ALL ARTWORK NOT CLAIMED BY THESE TIMES WILL BE DISCARDED.
 5. SUPERVISION OF STUDENT ARTISTS: Although representatives of *The West Volusia Beacon* will be on duty at the Student Division exhibit, **no baby-sitting services will be provided.** The parent or guardian who signs the front of this form agrees to provide supervision for children who are not old enough or responsible enough to remain unsupervised at the Art Festival.
 6. *The West Volusia Beacon* reserves the right to assign appropriate space at the Student Division to each exhibitor. The artist's name, school, grade level, age and so on must be filled out on the exhibit card and displayed with the student's artwork.
 7. *The West Volusia Beacon* reserves the right to reorganize the Student Division age categories if not enough entries are received in any category. Artists will be notified on Saturday, March 28, as to the structure of the divisions.
 8. Pets will not be allowed in the Student Division display area.
 9. The parking lot in front of the Student Division area closes PROMPTLY at 9 a.m. You may unload your artwork prior to 9 a.m. and then park elsewhere.
 10. Neither *The West Volusia Beacon* nor the DeLand Outdoor Art Festival Inc. assumes any responsibility or liability for the safe return of artwork entered in the Student Division.
10. **All artwork must be original.**
